

## Consequences and Rewards

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| <b>Gold Zone</b>   | You will receive a house point every time you reach Gold Zone. At the end of the half-term, all children who have been in Gold Zone will attend a Gold Zone party.  |
| <b>Green Zone</b>  | You will be allowed to attend the Green Zone Party in full at the end of the half-term if your behaviour is great most of the time.   |
| <b>Grey Zone</b>   | Your behaviour may result in you moving to Orange Zone. However, you can avoid this and move back to Green Zone within 15 minutes if you try hard—so do not worry!  |
| <b>Orange Zone</b> | You will miss your next break and dinnertime in reflection. The school will phone home and send a letter explaining what has happened today. For every Orange Zone, you will miss 10 minutes of the Green Zone Party.   |
| <b>Red Zone</b>    | You will miss your next 3 breaks and dinnertimes in the Reflection Room. The school will phone home and send a letter explaining what has happened today. If you have been in red zone your teacher will talk to Miss Green about how long of the Green zone party you will miss. |

### How it Works:

Every day you start off in Green Zone. If you work hard or behave really well, you might get moved to Gold Zone!

If you do not go into Orange or Red Zone in a half-term you will be able to go to a special Green Zone party in the last week.

Grey Zone is an chance for you to think about your behaviour and change what you are doing before it becomes more serious.

Orange Zone is for if your Grey Zone behaviour gets worse or if you do something serious.

Red Zone is for if your Orange Zone behaviour gets worse or if you do something very serious.

We are sure that most children will finish each day in the Green Zone or Gold Zone.

Your teachers will use this code of conduct to decide which zone to put you in.

#### Our school rules:

Always respect each other;

Treat everyone the way you want to be treated;

Always take responsibility for our actions;

Try our best at all times and keep each other safe.

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## Grey Zone Behaviours

If you do any of these things after being asked to stop, you will have to move your name to Grey Zone:

- You are talking when you have been told to work quietly;
- You do not follow instructions from an adult in school;
- You are disturbing others and preventing them from learning;
- Your behaviour means that you need a time-out from class.
- After a reminder if your behaviour distracts the learning of others you will be moved to grey zone.

In addition, if you continue to behave in this way after moving your name, you will be moved to Orange Zone.

If you improve your behaviour, you will be moved back to Green Zone within 15 minutes. You may have time out in your classroom to prevent an Orange Zone.

## Orange Zone Behaviours

If you do any of these things, you will have to move your name to Orange Zone:

- You use bad language or make rude signs with your hands on the playground or in the classroom;
- You are rude or disrespectful to a member of staff;
- You keep disturbing other children in class;
- You lose your temper and refuse to do as you are asked;
- Your behaviour means that you have to be sent to a partner classroom so as not to disturb others.

If your behaviour does not improve and you do not make positive choices Miss Lowe/Miss Hudson will be called.

## Red Zone Behaviours

If you do any of these things, you will have to move your name to Red Zone:

- You repeatedly lose your temper and refuse to cooperate.
- You throw an object to deliberately hurt somebody or damage something;
- You are involved in a fight;
- You keep upsetting another child deliberately;
- You use racist language or comments that upset a group of people;

Please note: if you are in Red Zone twice in a half-term, Miss Green and Miss Lowe will discuss how much of your Green Zone party you will be able to enjoy.
