KS4 Destinations for 2015 Leavers:

- **100%** of Year 11 leavers are meeting the duty to participate in learning is well above the overall Kirklees percentage of **97.7%**. This is an extremely pleasing result for Netherhall. These figures are an improvement on the 2014 figure when **98.73%** were **meeting the duty** to participate in learning.
- **5 pupils** have entered an **apprenticeship** this year which is an increase from **2014** when 2 pupils entered construction apprenticeships.
- A further **5 pupils** have entered **traineeships** which is a pre apprenticeship programme with work experience. A traineeship enables young people to improve GCSES in English and Maths and gain work experience in order to secure an apprenticeship in the future.
