

## Consequences and Rewards

Gold Zone	Your child will receive a sticker every time they reach Gold Zone. At the end of the half-term, all children who have been in Gold Zone will receive a certificate.
Green Zone	Your child will be allowed to attend the Green Zone Party in full at the end of the half-term.
Grey Zone	Your child's behaviour may result in them moving to Orange Zone. However, they can avoid this and move back to Green Zone.
Orange Zone	Your child will miss their next break and dinnertime in detention. The school will phone home and send a letter explaining what has happened today. For every Orange Zone, your child will miss 20 minutes of the Green Zone Party.
Red Zone	Your child will miss their next 3 breaks and dinner-times in the Reflection Room. The school will phone home and send a letter explaining what has happened today. For every Red Zone, your child will miss 40 minutes of the Green Zone Party.

### How it Works:

All children start the day in Green Zone. If they work hard, demonstrate excellent behaviour or do anything else their teacher deems of merit, they will be moved to Gold Zone.

All children who do not go into Orange or Red Zone within a half-term will receive a special Green Zone party in the last week.

Grey Zone is an opportunity for children to think about their behaviour and change what they are doing before it becomes more serious.

Orange Zone is for persistent Grey Zone behaviour or isolated serious incidents.

Red Zone is for persistent Orange Zone behaviour or isolated very serious incidents.

We are sure that most children will finish each day in the Green Zone or Gold Zone.

We believe it is important that children learn that their actions have consequences. We have different consequences for the different zones.

Teachers will use their professional judgment in applying this code of conduct.

## *Grey Zone Behaviours*

*If your child continues to do any of the following after being asked to stop, they will move their name to Grey Zone:*

- Your child is talking during a time when silent work is needed;*
- Your child does not follow instructions from an adult in school;*
- Your child is disturbing others and preventing them from learning;*
- Your child's behaviour results in them needing a time-out from class.*

*In addition, if your child continues to behave in this way after moving their name, they will be moved to Orange Zone.*

*If they improve their behaviour, they will be moved backed to Green Zone*

## *Orange Zone Behaviours*

*If your child does any of the following, they will move their name to Orange Zone:*

- Your child uses inappropriate language/gestures on the playground;*
- Your child is rude or disrespectful to a member of staff;*
- Your child is repeatedly disruptive in class;*
- Your child loses their temper and refuses to co-operate;*
- Your child's behaviour results in them being sent to another classroom so as not to disturb others.*

*In addition, if your child continues to behave in this way after moving their name, they will be moved to Red Zone.*

## *Red Zone Behaviours*

*If your child does any of the following, they will move their name to Red Zone:*

- Your child physically hurts another child (even in retaliation);*
- Your child throws an object to intentionally harm somebody or something;*
- Your child is involved in a fight;*
- Your child is involved in the persistent targeting of another child;*
- Your child uses racist language or comments that go against our inclusive ethos;*

*Please note: if your child is in Red Zone twice in a half-term, then a more serious consequence may apply and this issue will be dealt with by the Vice Principal or the Deputy Head teacher.*
