Exam time @ NLC

- 8:45am – form time.
 - 8:45am to 8:55am – going into exam venue
 - 9am – Exam begins.

Talking/communication

- No talking as soon as you enter the exam venue.
- Any talking has to be reported to the exam board.
- No “mouthing words”.
- No looking around the room.
- No turning in your chair.

Mobile Phones



- Mobile phones are not allowed in the exam venue.
- School advice is to not bring your mobile phone in on the day of an exam.
- If you do bring it in, then hand it in at the start of the exam.
- Make sure your mobile phone is switched off when handed in.

Ear Phones



- Ear phones are not allowed in the exam venue.
- School advice is to not bring your ear phones in on the day of an exam.
- If you do bring them in, then hand them in at the start of the exam.
- Make sure your ear phones are not in you ears when you enter the exam venue.

Smart Watches

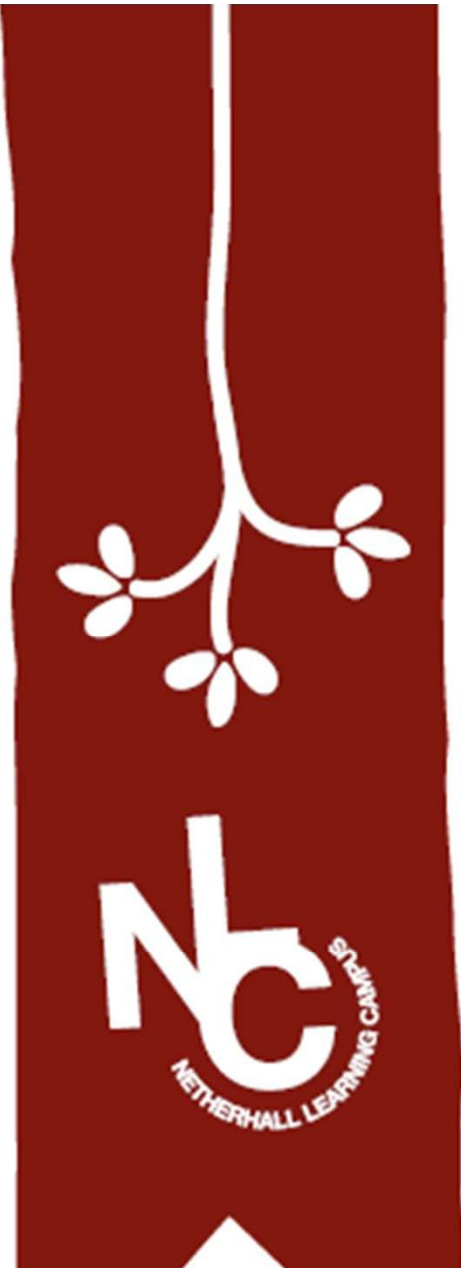


- Smart watches are not allowed in the exam venue.
- School advice is to not bring your smart watch in on the day of an exam.
- If you do bring it in, then hand it in at the start of the exam.
- Make sure your smart watch is not on your wrist when you enter the exam venue.

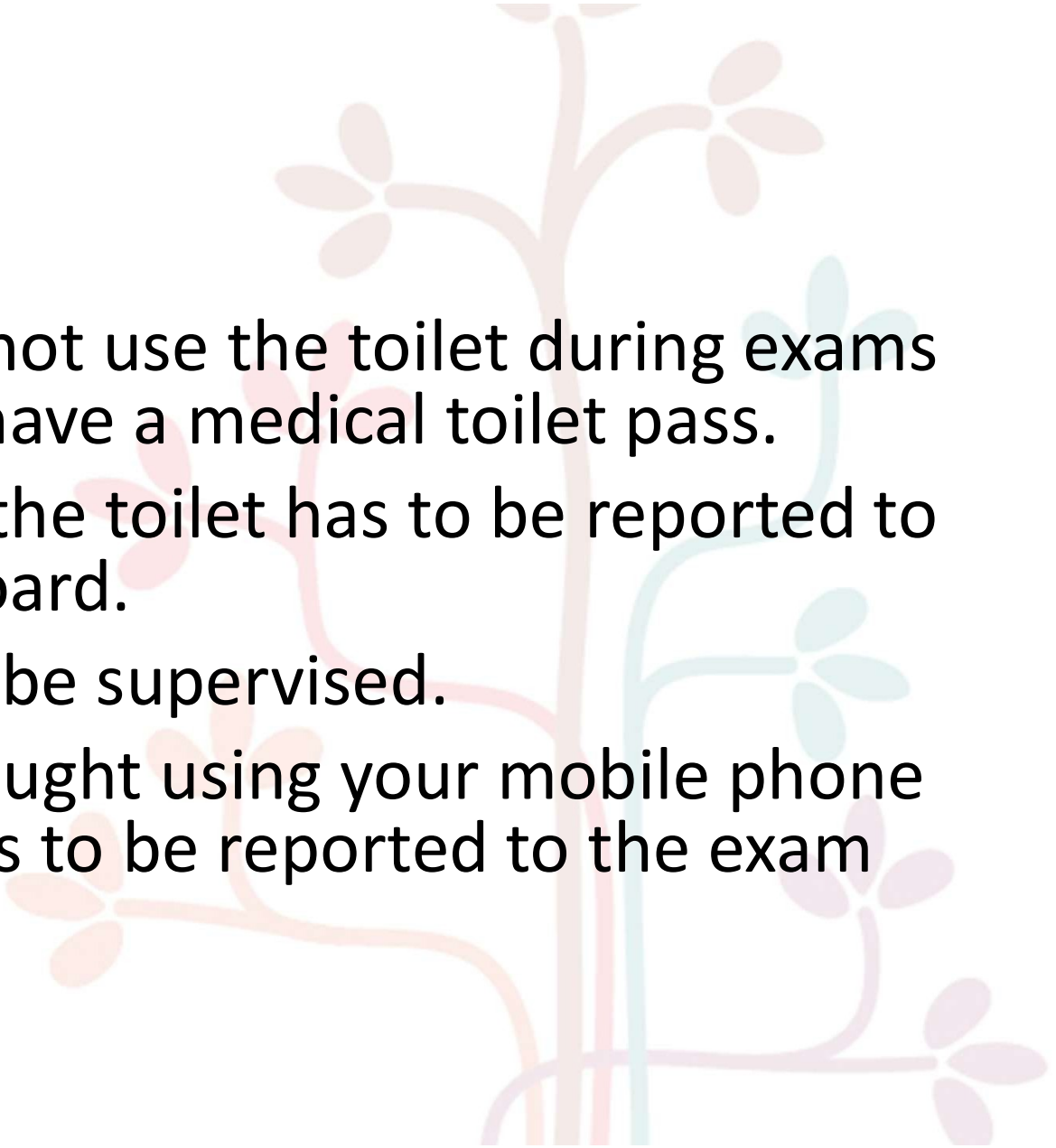
Bottles

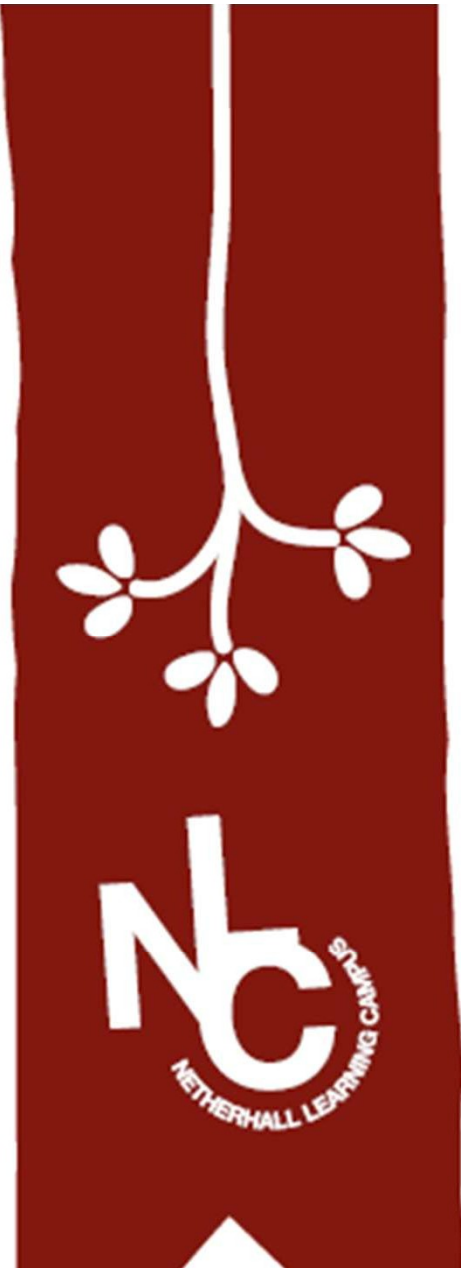
- You are allowed water in the exam.
- It must be in a clear plastic bottle.
- No labels.
- Completely transparent.



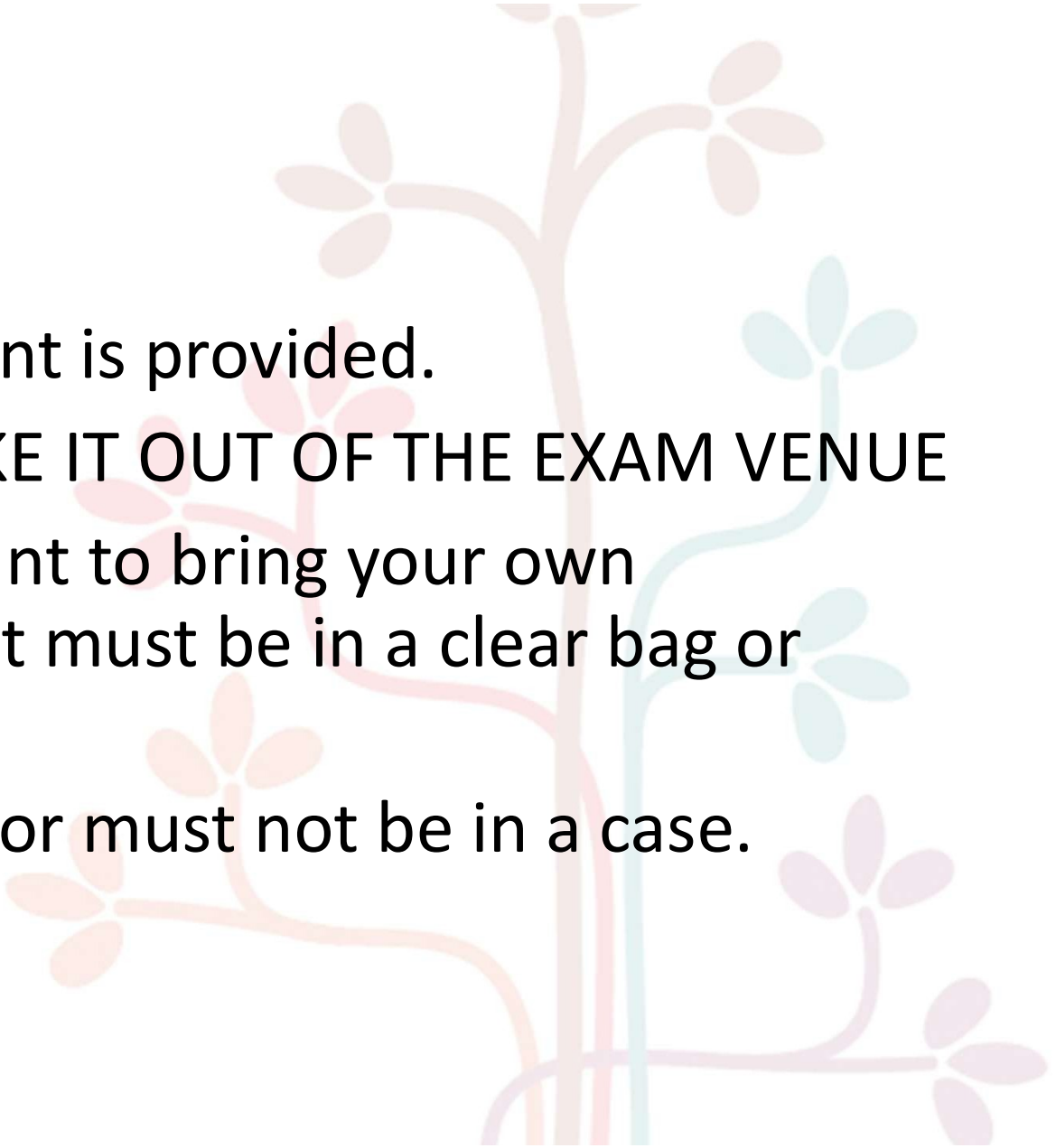


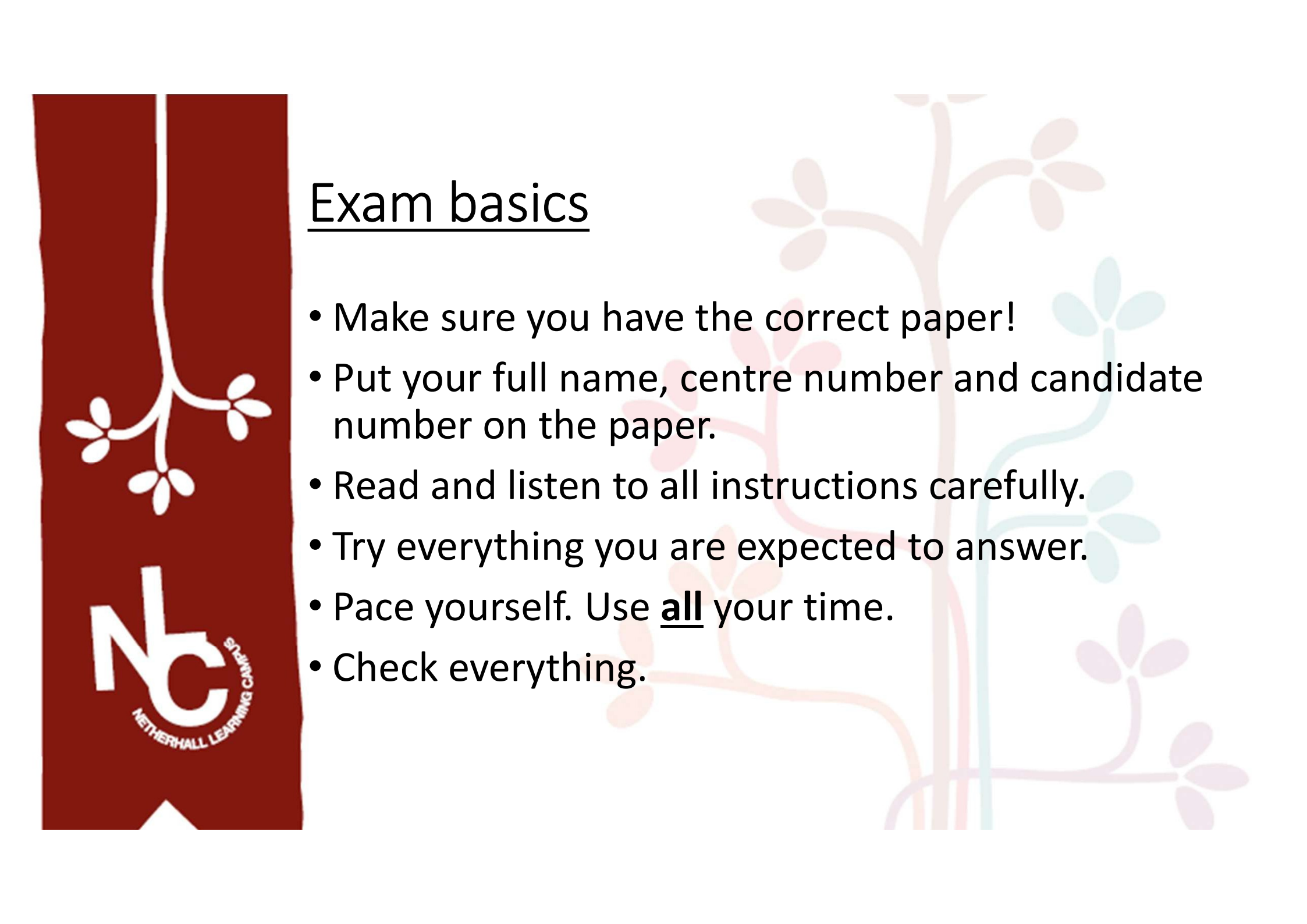
Toilet

- You should not use the toilet during exams unless you have a medical toilet pass.
 - Any visit to the toilet has to be reported to the exam board.
 - You have to be supervised.
 - If you are caught using your mobile phone then this has to be reported to the exam board.

Equipment

- All equipment is provided.
 - **DO NOT TAKE IT OUT OF THE EXAM VENUE**
 - If you do want to bring your own equipment it must be in a clear bag or pencil case.
 - Any calculator must not be in a case.
