IN JUNE 2026, ALL YEAR 10 STUDENTS WILL TAKE PART IN A ONE-WEEK WORK PLACEMENT, OFFERING A VALUABLE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPERIENCE THE WORLD OF WORK AND DEVELOP ESSENTIAL SKILLS SUCH AS COMMUNICATION, TEAMWORK, AND PROBLEM-SOLVING

TO SUPPORT STUDENTS IN PREPARING FOR THIS, THEY HAVE TAKEN PART IN THRIVE LESSONS AND WE RUN AFTER-SCHOOL SESSIONS EVERY THURSDAY FROM 3:15–4:00 PM IN IT4, WHERE PUPILS CAN RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES AND LEARN HOW TO APPROACH BUSINESSES FOR INSIGHT INTO THEIR WORKPLACE.

OVER RECENT YEARS, WE HAVE FOUND THAT THE MOST SUCCESSFUL PLACEMENTS HAVE BEEN THOSE SOURCED BY STUDENTS THEMSELVES, OFTEN THROUGH FAMILY, FRIENDS, OR BY CONTACTING COMPANIES THEY HAVE A GENUINE INTEREST IN.

WHILE SOME CAREER ASPIRATIONS MAY BE HARDER TO ACCESS AT THIS STAGE, WE RECOMMEND CONSIDERING GENERIC PLACEMENTS THAT STILL PROVIDE EXCELLENT EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS-SUCH AS VOLUNTEERING IN RETAIL CHARITY SHOPS LIKE BARNARDO'S, FORGET ME NOT, OR THE KIRKWOOD. THESE ORGANISATIONS HAVE WORKED WITH HUNDREDS OF VOLUNTEERS, HELPING THEM GAIN CONFIDENCE AND WORKPLACE EXPERIENCE WHILE GIVING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY.
