For year 11 students a third Mathematics and Science paper will be completed during lesson time the following week.

All examinations will be held in the Sports Hall. These assessments are an important part of preparing students for their GCSE examinations next summer, helping them build familiarity, confidence, and resilience in exam conditions.

To best support this process, please ensure that your child:

- **Arrives punctually and fully prepared for each exam.**
- **Brings the correct equipment** (including pens, pencils, ruler, calculator, etc.).
- **Engages in regular revision at home.** We strongly recommend the use of Sparx as an effective revision tool.

Examination Regulations

In line with national examination standards, the following items are not permitted in the exam hall: **Mobile phones, Smartwatches, MP3 players or any other connected devices.** We recommend that students leave such items at home or hand them in before the start of each exam. Misconduct during exams, whether mock or real, is taken very seriously. During official GCSEs, incidents must be reported to examination boards and can result in disqualification. Experiencing these same conditions now ensures that students understand and respect exam expectations.
