## Year 4 Autumn 2 2025 India

**English** - In English we will be reading 'When the Mountains Roared.' This is a story about a girl named Ruby who is forced to move from Australia to a hotel in the mountains in India. We will use this book as inspiration for our writing, putting ourselves into Ruby's shoes and writing a diary entry.

<u>Maths</u> - In Maths we will continue to learn about addition and subtraction. We will be studying area before moving onto learning about multiplication and division facts. We will also continue to recap out multiplication facts, using TTRS.

<u>Science</u> - We will be looking at sounds. Specifically looking at how our ears work, what creates sound and how sound travels.


