

Year 4 Spring 1 2026 The Vikings

English - In English we will be reading 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell. This is a story about how ten boys of the Viking Hairy Hooligan Tribe intend to become full members of their tribe by passing the Dragon Initiation Program. We will use this story as inspiration for our writing.

Maths - In Maths we will be learning about multiplication and division, looking closely at the 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 times tables. We will also practice formal written methods to multiply and divide.

Art - In Art we will learn about the different Viking art styles. We will use this research to inspire our own animal sketch including a Viking knot design.

R.E. - Children will learn about how the 5 pillars of Islam help Muslims to live a good life.

CLICK - In our CLICK topic we will be learning all about The Vikings. We will learn about where the Vikings came from and where they settled. We will also learn about what Viking life was like.

Science - In Science, we will learn about the different organs within the digestive system and their function. We will also learn about the different types of human teeth as well as carry out an experiment to see the effects of different liquids on teeth. Finally, we will look at how teeth differ in carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
