# WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

The campus will be monitoring each pupil's attendance and the parents/carers of any child who falls below the national average of 96% will be contacted by the school's attendance officer. Please be aware that pupils who are below 90% are referred to the local authority as they have fallen into the Persistent Absence category.

## **HOLIDAY ABSENCES IN TERM TIME**

Please complete an Absence Notification Form and return this to school. Please ensure your child returns on the agreed date. If we are not notified of a long term absence there is a possibility of the child being referred to Children Missing in Education and removed from the school roll.

In line with new government strategies absences in term time will no longer be authorised except in exceptional circumstances

## ABSENCE DUE TO ILLNESS/MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Please contact school on the first day of your child's absence to provide a reason. If we don't hear from you, school will contact parents using the texting service (replies can be sent back via this system) or telephone you directly. Once a reason is provided, this will be recorded on your child's register. Failure to provide a reason will result in an unauthorised absence.

In some cases, further action may be taken by school/authority.

## LATE FOR SCHOOL

If you have an appointment which will make your child late for school, please let us know in advance.

Whenever possible please make appointments after school or in school holidays. If you are unable to do so, please make them at the beginning or the end of the day and provide proof of the appointment where possible.

#### **REWARDS**

- Weekly BINGO classes earn a class reward for achieving BINGO A letter for every day that they achieve 100% attendance
- Each week we share the whole school attendance and punctuality during our celebration assembly. Classes receive trophies for attendance and rosettes for punctuality. Scores are added up on a weekly basis.
- > At the end of each term the class with highest attendance get to enjoy a treat.
- We also recognise the children who have may have been absent but have then worked hard to improve their attendance
- Class Dojo and website are used to encourage good attendance
- If whole school get 100% a whole school instant day reward will be granted

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
